Written reviews must be between 100-300 words, and include a short summary of the story, as well as a brief paragraph containing a critical evaluation and a personal response with specific examples to support praise or criticism. No spoilers, please!

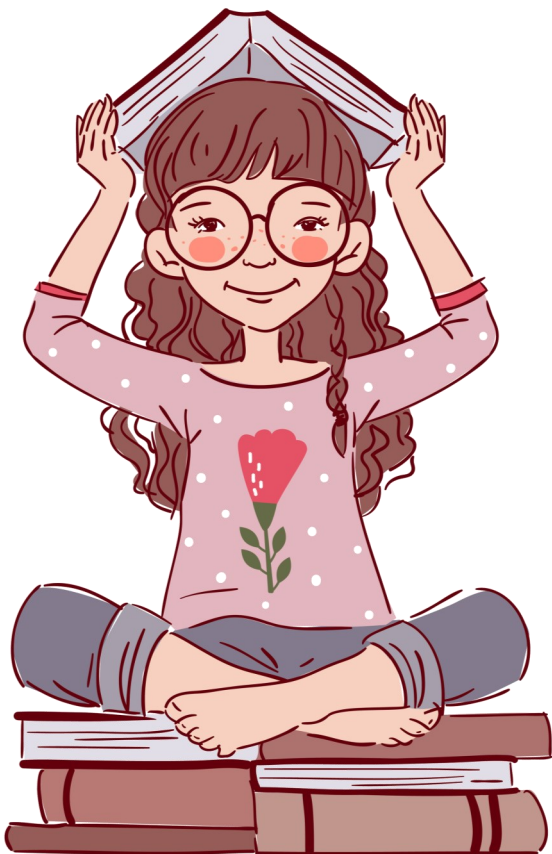

Service hours will be awarded upon approval by a Library staff member. Book reviews must follow the above guidelines, and may be returned if information is missing or unacceptable.

Please note that young adult/teen books in our teen sections cover a wide range of ages and vary in content and maturity level. Parents and/or guardians have the right and responsibility to determine their own teen's access to library resources.
