

Accessing the New York Times through the Library

Part 1: Gaining daily access to the *New York Times* through Monmouth County Library

Step 1: Go to www.MonmouthCountyLib.org

Step 2: On the website's main menu, go to the **RESEARCH** tab, then click on **Databases, Articles, & More**

Step 3: In the alphabetized list, scroll down and click on **New York Times**

Step 4: Next to the discount coupon code, click on **REDEEM**

Step 5: You will now need to create an account if this is your first time using the *New York Times*, OR you can simply log in with your current login credentials (an email and a password)

The redemption codes allow you to have 24 hours of access to the following 3 things:

1. www.NYTimes.com
2. the **New York Times mobile app**
3. the **New York Times Audio app** - to stream podcasts from home or while driving

Part 2: What to do if your daily access is still active

If you already logged into your *New York Times* account through the Library's website within the past 24 hours, and are now seeing a page that says that you already have an active subscription once you click on **REDEEM**, then you can simply go to www.NYTimes.com from any device and log in with your email and password.

Step 1: click on The New York Times logo, which will take you to www.NYTimes.com



Step 2: click on the top-right part of the page to log in
