


Getting Libby eBooks onto a Kindle

Before Beginning: Have the login credentials you will need on-hand.

- The email and password used to sign into the Amazon account that your Kindle is registered to.

Part 1: Find a Kindle-Friendly eBook on Libby

On the Libby mobile app

1. Search for an eBook on the *Libby* app.
2. Modify results to show Kindle-friendly items:
 - a. Tap on 
 - b. Scroll down to **Read With...**
 - c. Tap on **Kindle**
3. Tap on **Borrow**
4. Tap on **Borrow** again




On the Libby website

1. Search for an eBook on the *Libby* website.
2. Modify results to show Kindle-friendly items:
 - a. Click on **Filters**
 - b. Scroll down and click on **Ebooks**
 - c. Click on **Kindle Book**
3. Click on **Borrow**
4. Click on **Borrow** again

Part 2: Sending the eBook to your Kindle

1. On *Libby*, go to your current checkouts.
2. Click on **Read with...**
3. Click on **Kindle**.
4. When the *Amazon* login page appears, sign in with the email and password your Kindle is registered to.
 - You will only need to do this once, then Libby will remember the login credentials.
5. Verify the **Deliver To:** option has the name of the Kindle you want to read on.
 - If you send the eBook to the wrong Kindle location (e.g., the Kindle *app* instead of your Kindle *device*), then you can log into your Amazon account to send the eBook to the correct location.

6. Click on **Get Library Book**

Part 3: Refresh your Kindle and begin reading

1. Start up your Kindle, and make sure it is connected to wifi.
2. On the top of the Kindle screen, tap and swipe down to open the Kindle's settings. ()
3. Tap on **Sync** 
4. Tap the upwards arrow to close the settings menu. ()
