

Access Rosetta Stone through the Monmouth County Library Application

Before Beginning:

Download the *Rosetta Stone: Learn Languages* application from your device's app store

- Do not launch the *Rosetta Stone* app after it is installed.
- The application needs to be opened from the Library's link – otherwise it will ask you to purchase a private subscription.

Download the *Monmouth County Library* application from your device's app store.

Part 1: Link your library card with the *Monmouth County Library* application

1. Open the *Monmouth County Library* application.
2. Tap on **My Account**.
3. Tap on **Mobile Account Setup**.
4. Tap on **ADD ACCOUNT**.
5. Log in with your library card number, and tap on **VALIDATE** to save.

Part 2: Get into the *Rosetta Stone* through the *Monmouth County Library* application

1. On the *Monmouth County Library* application's home page, tap on **Research Tools**
2. Tap on **Rosetta Stone**.
3. Enter the following:
Username: the email you will use to log in each time
Password: the password you choose
Choose Language to Learn: the language you want to study
4. Tap on **SIGN IN**.
5. The *Rosetta Stone* application will now automatically open, and the lessons for your chosen language will begin.

If the *ROSETTA STONE* application still asks you to sign in:

1. On the *Rosetta Stone* application's home page, tap on **Have an account? Log In**.
2. Tap on **Work or School**
3. Enter the following:
Username: the email you will use to log in each time
Password: the password you choose
Workspace: cjrlc317
4. On the top right, tap on **Sign In**
