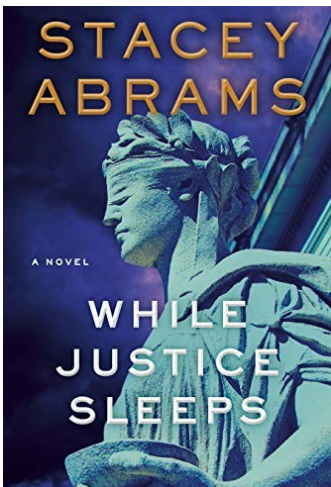


# A NOVEL IDEA: VIRTUAL BOOK DISCUSSIONS

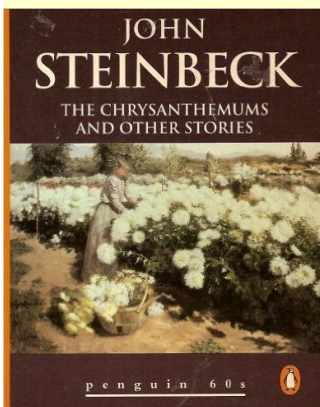
### *While Justice Sleeps* by Stacey Abrams
