November 2020 through August 2021

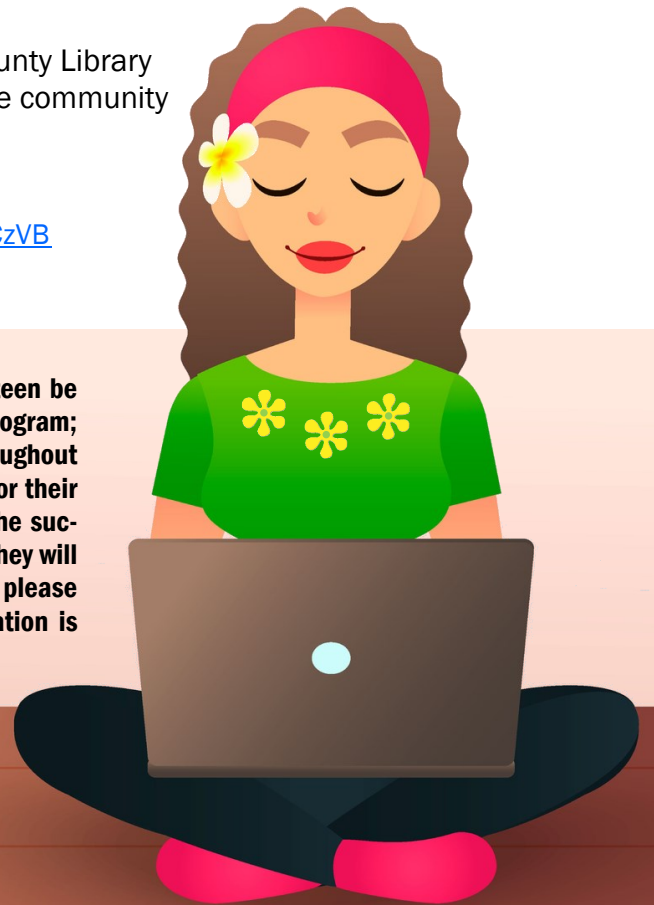

Entries must follow all guidelines to be approved and accepted.

Prospective participants must have a valid Monmouth County Library Card and are limited to two submissions each, to earn one community service hour per entry.
