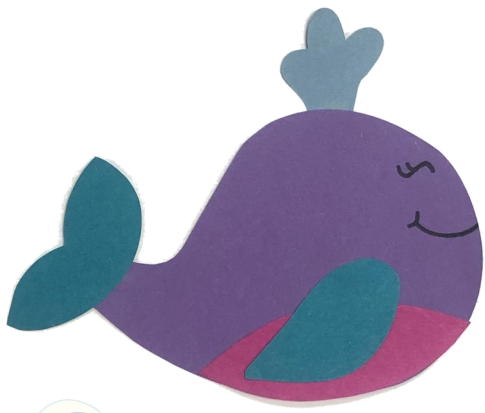


Monmouth County Library Presents...

Additional Supplies needed:

- Glue or glue stick
- Crayons, markers, color pencils, or even chalk!

Instructions:

1. Arrange pieces as shown above. Glue pieces together or onto a piece of paper.
2. Then use crayons, markers, or color pencils to add any extra details you'd like!

WAIT! Add some fun if you have...

- *Wiggly Eyes*: Glue these on to give your whale personality!
- *Shimmery Paper, Felt, or Fabric*: Trace and cut out the fin and tail from these instead!
- *Colored Paper*: Glue the whale onto a background paper and create an ocean scene.
- *Blue Tissue paper*: Add a twist of paper to make the water spout three-dimensional!

Remember, your project doesn't have to look like ours, so go ahead and get creative!

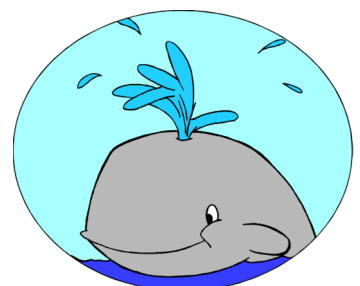
