Additional Supplies needed:

- Glue or glue stick
- Crayons, markers, colored pencils, or even chalk!

Instructions:

1. Arrange pieces as you like, look to picture above.
2. Glue pieces onto blue background paper.
3. Remove the sticker eyes from their paper and stick directly onto the paper.
4. Add details such as a mouth, snowflakes, and more!

WAIT! Add some fun if you have...

- ◆ *A black pompom or scrunched-up black tissue paper: Make a three dimensional nose!*
- ◆ *Cotton balls: Tear up a few cotton balls to add fur to the polar bear!*
- ◆ *White tissue paper: Tear into little pieces to create falling snow!*
- ◆ *White or blue glitter/glitter-glue: Add icy details!*

Remember, your project doesn't have to look like ours, so go ahead and get creative!
