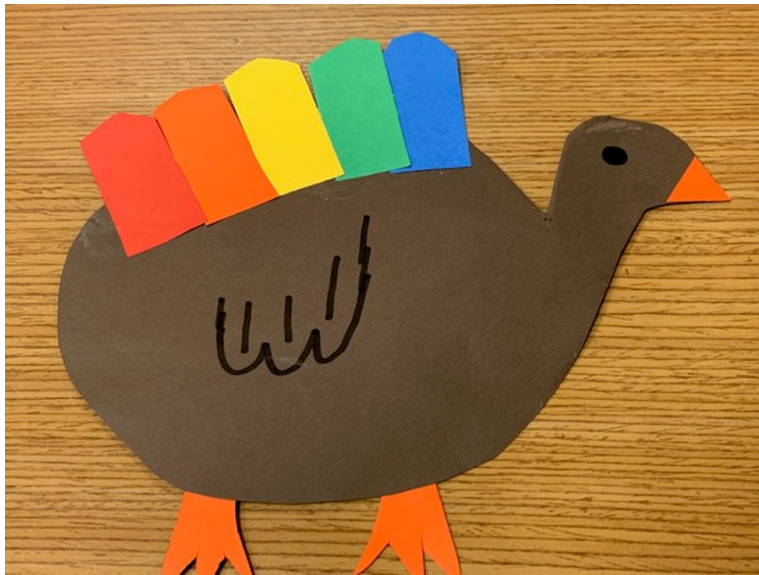


# Monmouth County Library Presents...



## Colorful Turkey Craft

### Additional Supplies needed:

- Glue or glue stick
- Crayons, markers, colored pencils, or even chalk!

### Instructions:

1. Arrange pieces as you like, look to picture above.
2. Glue them onto the Turkey's body.
3. Add details such as an eye, a wing, and more!

### **WAIT! Add some fun if you have...**

- Dried leaves, tissue paper, or real feathers: Use as the feathers instead of, or with, the paper ones to add to your Turkey's uniqueness!
- One wiggle eye or button: Use as an eye instead of drawing one!
- Red tissue paper, felt, or foam: Add a wattle to the turkey's chin!
- A pen or pencil: Make the Turkey extra thankful by writing on each paper feather something you are thankful for, such as "family", "friends", or even "the library"!

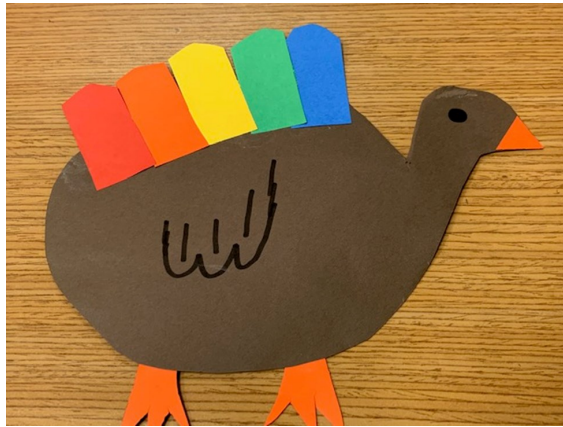
*Remember, your project doesn't have to look like ours, so go ahead and get creative!*

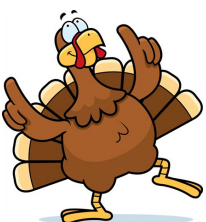
